- Have you registered your cell and VOIP phones at www.911.org?
- Have you downloaded the **ReadyHarris** app from your smart phone app store?
- Have you looked at the websites of cities from which you want community warnings and signed up for whatever community warning systems they have—cell, text, email, app?
- **Have you downloaded the new CAER Online app?** The EHCMA CAER Online app is now available for download! **To download the app, search "EHCMA CAER Online" in the Apple and Google Play stores.** In addition, you can reach the app via the links provided below, or the QR Code in the attached graphic.
- When viewing the Latest CAER Messages from the app, you can click on each message to view the full content, share the message, and access the website at www.caeronline.org. We are still working to fix a couple of items with the RSS feed on both the app and website. As we move forward, we will continue to make improvements to the process.
- The CAER Line phone number is being phased out.
- If your city or the county calls for a shelter in place for an impacted part of the community, they will communicate by telephone notification systems. Most can also send text and email messages, and use social media. Some have their own apps and other notification systems. Go to the city and Harris County websites to sign up for what they offer. The CAER Online app includes links to your community's website.
