



Mission

The DPCAC is a forum for an open and frank mutual exchange of ideas between representatives of the local community and industry. The group engages in frequent dialogue to develop a shared understanding of the interdependency of industry and community. The DPCAC serves as a resource to industry and the community at large topics such as health, occupational, environmental and economic issues.

Organization

The DPCAC meets 9-10 times a year. Members select agenda items, focusing on topics that relate to industry and include:

Health -- Safety -- Environment – Security -- Transportation -- Emergencies
Economy – Education

The organization addresses topics by group discussion, plant presentations and data-sharing, tours of plants and related facilities, and inviting outside speakers to share their views. Meetings are run by a neutral third-party facilitator.

Membership

DPCAC members include individuals who live, work or attend school in Deer Park, and organizations and government entities serving Deer Park.

Industry members represent a petrochemical plant, refinery, storage terminal, or other industrial facility located in Deer Park. The DPCAC keeps the proportion of community-to-industry members approximately two-to-one.
