HISTORY



ESTABLISHMENT OF DPCAC

In **December 1989**, the Industry Steering Group met and discussed the purpose of the DPCAC, established a budget, and selected a core group to help them form “Ad Hoc CAP” (Joe Foster and Jack Coe of Rohm and Haas; Dave Scholes of Occidental Chemical; Joe Hodge of Lubrizol; and Ron Kingsbury and Peter Fischer of Shell).

On **January 30, 1990**, community members (Theresa Hartley, Mike Jackson, Buddy Bishop, Jimmy Burke, Larry Power, BJ Power) help plants organize the “Deer Park Ad Hoc Community Advisory Panel.”

In **February 1990**, organizers developed goals, objectives, membership criteria, and selected community members to invite to become members.

On **March 2, 1990**, the Industry Steering Group agreed to commitments made to date and arranged plans for the first meeting. 10 companies are interested in attending, but only four are to send representatives initially.

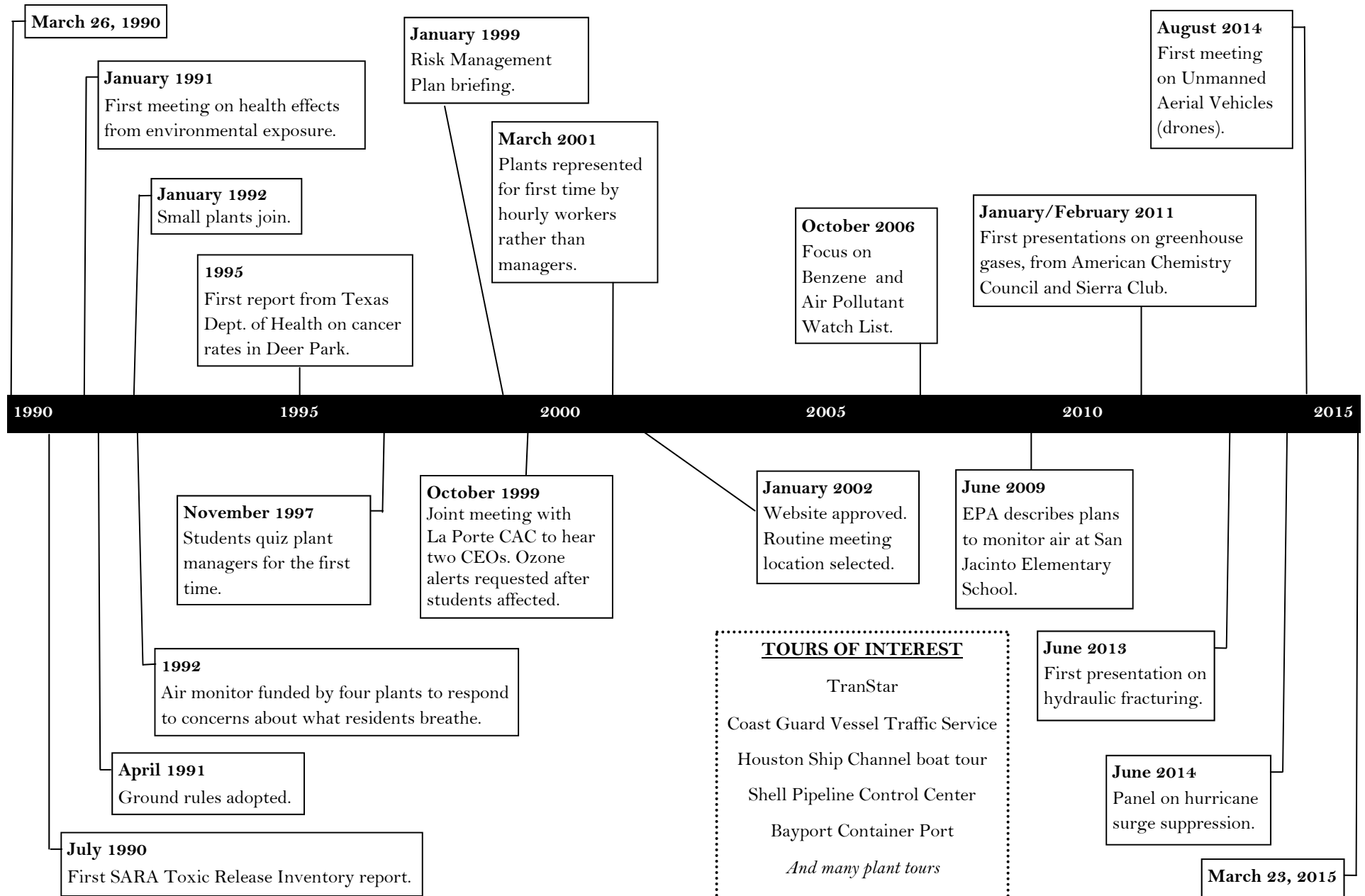
