Tour of the Houston Area Safety Council

Deer Park Community Advisory Council (DPCAC) learned about the workplace training and occupational health services offered by the Houston Area Safety Council (HASC). Cami Hysler, Vice President of Operations, and Dr. Tommy Hysler provided an overview of HASC's programs and role in the community. Attendees learned about HASC's computer-based training, hands on training, and health services including substance abuse testing, respirator and hearing protection fit testing, physical exams and 24/7 injury care for workplace accidents. The tour of HASC's LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified buildings included classroom spaces, computer labs, the auditorium, skills areas like the virtual reality welding classroom and hands-on training spaces for rigging, welding, scaffolding, crane and forklift operations. The facility is open to the public, and sees approximately 1,800-2,000 trainees daily, and about 300-400 patients. Currently, HASC offers about 1,700 courses, and delivers about 1 million units of training annually.
