

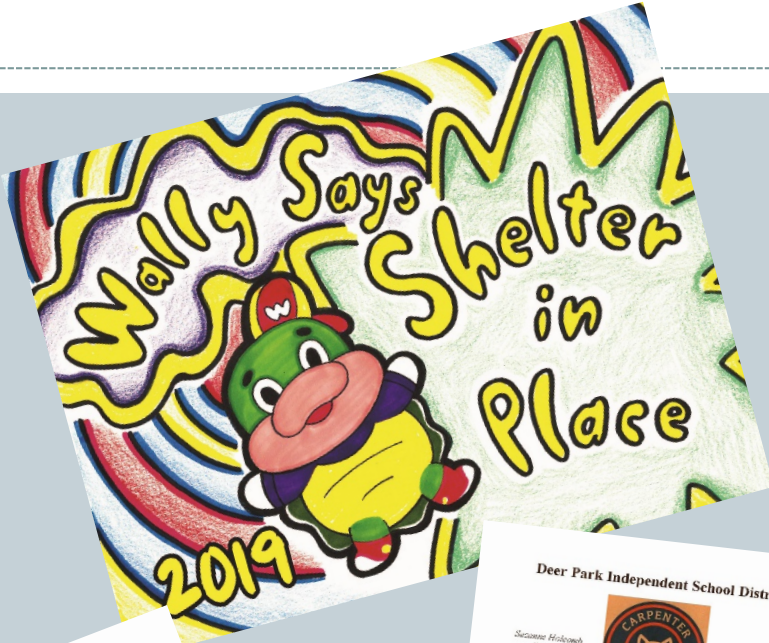

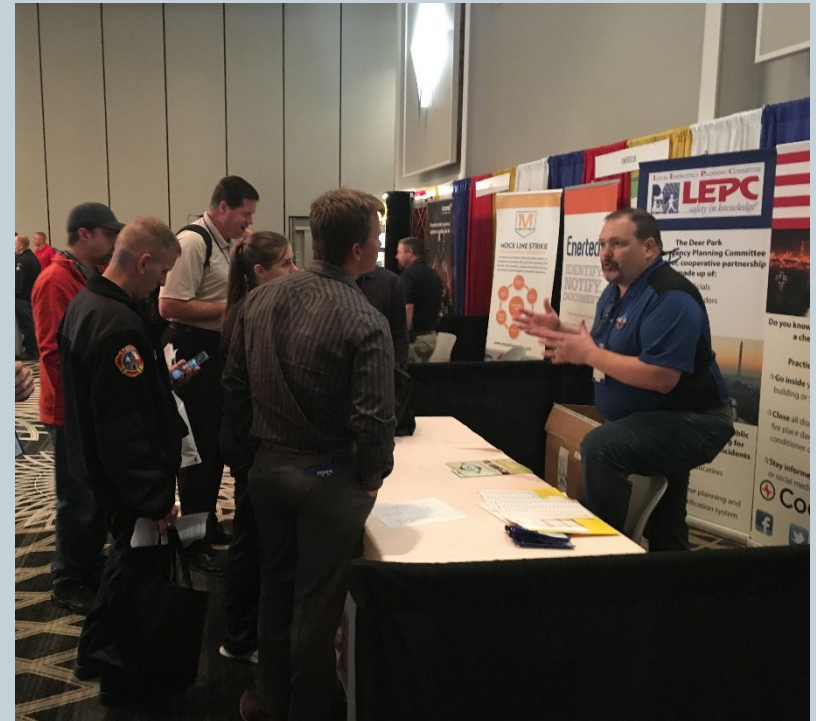

Wally Wise Guy

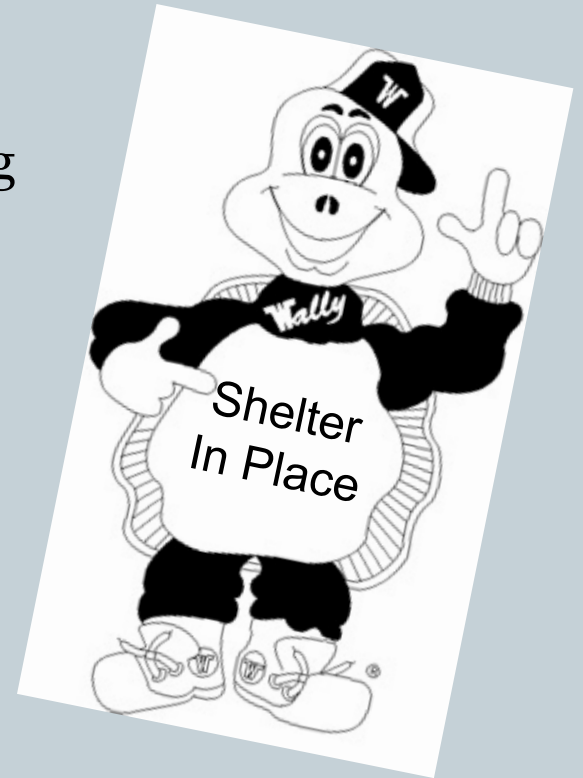


- In 2018, Wally turned 25 Years Old!

3 Steps:

1. Go Inside

2. Close Up

3. Stay Informed



Shelter In Place



- When the alarm sounds...
- ...and you're indoors:
 - Remain calm.
 - Stay put - no matter where you are!
 - Close all doors, windows, and other openings (cracks/gaps).
 - Turn off the AC/Heater.
 - Stay off the phone – authorities will be sending out messages with updates!
 - Follow directions given by authorities.
 - Stay informed: Television, Radio, Internet, Facebook, etc.



Shelter In Place



- When the alarm sounds...
- **...and you're outdoors:**
 - Remain calm.
 - Go inside the nearest building – home, business, etc.
 - Close all doors, windows, and other openings (cracks/gaps).
 - Turn off the AC/Heater.
 - Stay off the phone – authorities will be sending out messages with updates!
 - Follow directions given by authorities.
 - Stay informed: Television, Radio, Internet, Facebook, etc.



Shelter In Place



- When the alarm sounds...
- **...and you're in a vehicle:**
 - Remain calm.
 - Close all doors, windows, and other openings (cracks/gaps).
 - Turn off the AC/Heater.
 - Drive to the nearest business/building and go inside quickly.
 - Stay off the phone – authorities will be sending out messages with updates!
 - Follow directions given by authorities.
 - Stay informed: Television, Radio, Internet, Facebook, etc.
