Every 10 years, the census counts how many people are in our community to decide how much federal funding and representation our communities should receive. This money supports everything from disaster recovery to road improvements to over 130 other programs that could help your family right now.

Your responses to the census are important, and they cannot be shared with anyone. In fact, they're even protected by law from other branches of government.

After the 2010 census, we missed out on over \$10,000* per person not listed on the census. Everyone should fill out Census 2020 so we don't lose millions of dollars in the next 10 years!

Let's say no to undercounting in our communities and #YESstotheCensus.

This April, the census can be filled out by mail, phone or online at 2020census.gov.

The census is only nine responses and takes 10 minutes to complete.
